Graduate Student Fellow Application

Graduate students whose focus will be on military history may apply to become a Graduate Student Fellow of the UNT Military History Center. Benefits to being a Graduate Student Fellow include eligibility to apply for MHC graduate student travel grants and for MHC scholarships.

Criteria for qualification as a UNT MHC Student Fellow

Have committed to doing a thesis or dissertation in military history

Be working with a major advisor or co-advisor who is an MHC Faculty Fellow

Have taken at least two military history courses with UNT MHC Faculty Fellow instructors

Have and maintain a GPA of 3.5 or above in all graduate courses

Be a registered student in good standing in the UNT History graduate program

Submit and have approved by the MHC Executive Committee:

- An application form
- A letter of intent
- A letter of recommendation from a UNT faculty member

Procedure for applications and approval

Applications will be reviewed once every academic year. Applications are due by December fifth. The Military History Center's Executive Committee will review and respond to all applications by January thirty-first.
